Care Bundles: Partnering with the Archdiocese and Catholic Charities, we ask that you donate new hygiene items during the month of August until September 24. The items needed are bar soap, laundry soap, shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, and toothbrushes. Collection boxes are located at each entrance (St. Vincent de Paul boxes).

St Bernadette is the collection point for our deanery. We will meet in their cafeteria on Wednesday, September 25th from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM to make bundles of these items. Volunteers are needed for this task and a sign-up sheet is available in the back of church.

Clean Up: The Faith-based Organization of Milwaukee Police District #4 sponsors an Adopt-A-Block program. Volunteers meet twice a month in the Millwood neighborhood on Saturday mornings to pick up trash and interact with residents. We meet at 105th and Mill Road at 11:00 AM. A brief prayer is shared, equipment is distributed (reflective vests, garbage bags, picker uppers) and we walk through the neighborhood picking up trash and greeting and talking to any residents we encounter. We are usually accompanied by a Community Liaison officer. This takes one hour and then we go our separate ways.

We've chosen this as one of our projects and hope you will join us on Saturday, September 28th at 11:00 AM.

"Friends of the Poor" Walk: This is a fundraiser sponsored by St. Vincent de Paul to "stop hunger". All proceeds benefit St. V's meal program. Last year over \$20,000 was raised and 89,514 meals were served.

The walk starts at St. Alphonsus Church (6060 W. Loomis Rd.) and ends in Scout Lake Park, Greendale.
